5. Purpose and legal basis of data processing

We collect your personal data to add you as a Newsletter subscriber and for us to send you the Newsletter.

Your data is processed pursuant to Article 6 (1) b) GDPR.

Please note that by subscribing to our Newsletter you agree that your personal data is processed. You may withdraw your consent at any time with effect for the future.

6. Recipient or categories of personal data recipients

Your personal data will be transmitted to:

- our service partners who administrate, generate and who we send the Newsletter out with
- our IT service provider

Specific purpose:

- subscription to Newsletter
- sending of Newsletter
- termination of Newsletter subscription
- ensure GDPR compliant IT security standards

7. Transmission of personal data to a third country

It is intended to transmit your personal data to a third country (Canada).

In any case, your personal data will be transmitted to our Canada based IT service provider in order to implement and secure GDPR compliant IT security standards.

Your personal data is carried out by means of an online web application. Therefore confidentiality, integrity (inviolability), authenticity (genuineness) and availability of personal data cannot be guaranteed.

8. Duration of storage of personal data

Your personal data will be saved for the duration of your subscription to the Newsletter.



9. Rights of the data subject

You have the following rights according to the EU General Data Protection Regulation:

If your personal data is processed, you have the right to obtain information regarding the storage of your personal data (Article 15 GDPR).

If incorrect personal data is processed, you have the right to correction of such (Article 16 GDPR).

If legal requirements are given, you have the right to request the deletion or limitation of processing, and you have the right to object to such processing (Articles 17, 18 and 21 GDPR).

In the event of an objection, we will no longer be able to reach you as our member, and membership with our organization will be terminated.

Since data processing is based on a contract, and since data processing is carried out via automated processes, you have a right to data portability where applicable (Article 20 GDPR).

Should you exercise your above mentioned rights, CGCIC Canada will review whether statutory requirements are met.

In case of data protection complaints please contact the responsible regulatory authority.

10. Right to withdraw consent

In case you agreed on processing personal data, you may withdraw your consent at any time with effect for the future. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.
